

LESSON: Presenting a PowerPoint or Slide Show

GRADE: K

OBJECTIVES:

MATERIALS & RESOURCES:

- Computer
- Projector
- PowerPoint or Slideshow Presentation (made from student photos in the *Create a PowerPoint or Slideshow* lesson under the Science section of Clean & Green program)

PRESENTATION:

Explain that the class will be showing their PowerPoint presentation (or slide show) of the nature sculptures they created in the lesson on Andy Goldsworthy to another class, PTA or group of parents.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Talk with the students about to whom they would like to show their presentation—school faculty and administrators, another classroom, a group of parents.
2. If other classes are making slide shows or creating puppet shows or plays, explore the idea of putting together a show including all of the class projects.
3. Schedule the presentation and show the presentation.

4. After the show, form a circle with the students and ask questions like these—
 - a. What happened as we developed our slide show?
 - b. Are there things you would do differently now that you've done it once?
 - c. How do you feel about the show we just put on?
 - d. What did you learn?
 - e. What did you like best?
 - f. Did you get any new ideas from the show we just presented (and watched)?
 - g. What can our class do to follow up this show?

- What happened during this activity?
- What did the audience say after they saw it?
- What did you learn from this activity?

SO WHAT?

- How did it feel to share your PowerPoint presentation?
- What pillars of character did you use during this activity?

- What will you do differently the next time you are working with classmates on a project?
