

FACILITATOR GUIDE: Demonstration Video

GRADE: 9th – 12th

CONCEPTS & SKILLS:

- Students use technology to gather appropriate data, analyze its application to a task, and assess its effectiveness in order to design, develop, and test possible solutions that assist students in making decisions.

MATERIALS & RESOURCES:

- Video camera
- Video editing software

PRESENTATION:

Students will demonstrate the outcome of the service project by creating a video. Some examples of format are: a newscast, a how-to video, collage of various photos or art work that illustrate that shows what they learned, skills gained, accomplishments, etc....

DIRECTIONS:

1. Students video the material they feel demonstrates the outcome of their project. Consider having video available on the Teachers-Going-Green.com website.
